Click on “Sign in” – to set up account. <u>Only need to do this once.</u>3. Type in email address and select “create account”.4. Type in last name and phone number and select “submit”.5. Select “continue” and enter all information. Then select “save profile”. Note: can enter “o (zero)” for license number.6. <u>Once account is set up</u>, select “sign in”, enter e-mail address and password.7. Select “Online Programs” and click on “Pharmacist Education”.8. Find: PipelineRx: Antimicrobial Prophylaxis in Patients with Cancer-Related Immunosuppression. Select “Register”, then “Submit” registration.9. Select “Begin Activity” and then “View content”.10.
